A Note about Medication(s)

POLICIES

Fees & Deposit

The fee that is stated in the application is all inclusive. A deposit is required when the application is submitted. The deposit is not in addition to, but included in the fee.

Registration, Fees Payment & Refund Policy

Applications are accepted for complete sessions only. To get the most out of the camp experience, campers may not come and go during a session.

All camper applications must be filled out completely and mailed with a deposit of \$300 to Prairie Wildlife's "B" Outdoors Summer Camp, Prairie Wildlife, 6111 Old Vinton Road, West Point, Mississippi 39773. The deposit is refundable if written cancellation is received by March 1, 2011, nonrefundable thereafter. The balance of the fee (i.e. the fee minus \$300 deposit) must be paid by May 1, 2011 and is nonrefundable except for documented physical illness.

Forms

All forms must be completed and sent to Prairie Wildlife's "B" Outdoors Summer Camp May 1, 2011.

Visitation

To promote camp unity and to give campers a feeling of independence and self-reliance, we request that parents not visit campers during their week at camp. We encourage parents to tour the camp and meet the camp director and counselors on the opening day of the camp session.

Care Packages

Please don't send packages to your camper. Using the "What to Bring to Camp" list as a guide, your child should be well equipped for his week at camp. The fine kitchen staff of the Prairie Wildlife's "B" Outdoors Summer Camp will take good care of all the nutritional needs of your child.

Telephone

Campers may not use the phone while they're at camp unless there is a family emergency.

Cell Phones, Video Game Players, Laptops, Electronics, etc.

Cell phones, video game players, video games, laptop computers and other personal electronic devices (mp3 players, iPods, iPad, Kindle, Nook, etc.), knives, guns, or live animals are not permitted at camp. It is the responsibility of the parents to make sure that their child does not bring these to camp.

Pictures of Your Camper

We will be posting pictures of each camp session on our website from time to time, but on a daily basis, we will send a picture of your camper to your cell phone, so you can share in his daily experiences at camp.

Camper Correspondence

We encourage you to write your camper. It's fun to get mail! Your camper's **“What to Bring to Camp”** list suggests that the camper bring stationary, note cards, post cards and stamps. Your child will have an opportunity to write during his rest period or during free time.

Other Policies

Prairie Wildlife's "B" Outdoors Summer Camp reserves the right to refuse the application of any child who, in our judgment, will not benefit from our camp experience.

Prairie Wildlife's "B" Outdoors Summer Camp also reserves the right to dismiss a camper from camp if their behavior is in any way disruptive to our camp mission. **The use of alcohol, tobacco, or non-prescription drugs is not permitted and will result in immediate dismissal. If your camper requires prescription drugs, bring them to camp in the prescription bottle from the pharmacy along with a signed “Permission to Administer Medication” form and give them to the camp director or counselor at check-in.**

Bills for accidents and illnesses requiring outside medical attention will be forwarded to you for submission to your insurance company.
